

## Jesse Tatum and Amy Byrd Timeline

- abt 1762 **Halifax Co., NC.** Son **Jesse Tatum** was born<sup>1</sup> to Edward Tatum & Martha (prob. Bynum). Data are from [www.dar.org](http://www.dar.org), as his wife, Amy, was the daughter of John Byrd of Albemarle Parish, VA, and Hall Co., GA, DAR Ancestor # A010328. Also, birth date determined from a comparison of censuses for Jesse Tatum in 1790 Chatham Co., NC (b. 1774/earlier); 1800 Pendleton District, SC (1756/1774); no 1810 census found. Location of birth is from timeline for father, Edward.
- 1775/1783 Sometime during this period **John Tatum** served in the American Revolutionary War, and his brother **Jesse** served also. From handwritten notes about family history by a descendant's (Diane Doyle Stephens) deceased father.
- abt 1783 **Probably Chatham Co., NC.** **Jesse Tatum and Amy Byrd** were married.<sup>2</sup>
- 1790 **Chatham Co., NC.** Federal Census, Hillsborough District, p. 218, **Jesse Tatom.** >16 M - 1, <16 M - 1, all F - 2.
- 06 Jul 1791 **Chatham Co., NC.** **Jessey Tatum** of Chatham County, North Carolina, deeded to **George Lucas** of same, for 100 lbs, tract or parcel of land lying the fork of the Haw River of Robinsons Creek...to **Isham Gunter's** line...to the mouth of a branch on the River..... 260 acres. Signed; Jessey "x" Tatum. Witnesses: **Overton Daniel, Salley "X" Letbetter.** August Court 1791.<sup>3</sup>
- 21 Apr 1798 **Pendleton District, SC.** **Joseph Duncan** (signed) of Pendleton Co. SC, to **Jesse Tatum**, \$210, 120 acres on Wolf Creek. Wit. **John Bynum Sen, Sarah Bird.** Rec. 25 Aug.1798 on oath of **John Bird Senr.**<sup>4</sup>
- 02 May 1798 **Pendleton District, SC.** **Joseph Duncan** of Pendleton Co. SC to **Edward Tatum**, \$260, 130 acres on Wolf Creek, part of grant to **Joseph Duncan** by patent 6 Feb. 1786, ... mouth of a branch .... Wit. **Jesse Tatum, Wm. Marchbanks.** Rec. 25 Aug. 1798 by wit.<sup>5</sup>
- 1800 **Pendleton District, SC.** Federal Census. **Jesse Tatam (Tatum)**, p. 113. 1 male 25 to 45, 1 male 16 to 25, 2 males under 10, 1 female under 10, 1 female 26 to 45.
- 01 Nov 1802 **Pendleton District, SC.** **Jesse Tatum** sold his 120 acres on Wolf Creek to **Jesse Bynum.**<sup>6</sup> **William Bynum** was a witness. (Jesse Bynum was a cousin of Jesse Tatum.)
- 1803 **Franklin Co., GA.** No precinct given: **Edw Tatum, Edward Tatum, Jesse Tatum.**<sup>7</sup>

- 15 Aug 1804 **Anderson Co., SC. Charles Rice** of Walton Co., GA, lawful attorney for his father, **Henry Rice** of Tennessee (sic), for \$234 sold **Jesse Tatum** of Pendleton Dist., 468 acres granted **Henry Rice** by **Thos. Pinckney**, 5 Nov 1787, on Wolf and Rice Creeks of 12 Mile River. Date: 15 Aug 1804 Wit: **T. W. Farrar, Wm. Hamilton. Thomas W. Farrar** made oath to **M. Hammond**, D.C., 15 Aug 1805.<sup>8</sup>
- 18 May 1808 **Pendleton District, SC. Edward Tatum** to **Nathaniel Duncan**, \$300, 197-1/2 acres, part of land Tatum purchased of **Ferdinand Hopkins**, waters of Wolf Creek waters of 12 mile River, **Charles Durham's** line. Wit. **Daniel Duncan, Jesse Tatum**.<sup>9</sup>
- 22 Aug 1808 **Pendleton District, SC**, Deed Book M., p. 25. **James Jett** of Pendleton to **Russell Cannon** of same; for \$1 sold 207 acres on branches of Rices Creek waters of Twelve mile River; border: begins at a pine knot in **Hall's** line and joins **Jesse Tatum**. (signed) James Jett; wit: **Wm Jameson sr. & Wm Cannon jr**; wit. oath 22 Aug 1808 by William Cannon jr<sup>10</sup> before William Jameson JP; recorded 21 Nov 1812.<sup>11</sup>
- 1810 Federal Census: Jesse Tatum not located.
- 1815 **Elbert Co., GA.** Captain Dunston Blackwills. **Jesse Tatum**.<sup>12</sup>
- 24 Mar 1818 **Anderson Co., SC. Jesse Tatum** sold to **William Cox** 688 acres. Book O, p. 361. Which Jesse Tatum was this? Was this the son of Edward & Martha or of John & unknown?
- 1820 **Elbert Co., GA.** Federal Census. Jesse Tatum, p. 181. 1 m 45/older, 2 males 16-25, 1 female 45 or older, 3 females 16-25, 1 female under 10.
- 1820 **Elbert Co., GA.** **Jesse Tatum, Thomas Tatum**.<sup>13</sup>
- 30 Oct 1825 **Elbert Co., GA.** Had 2 draws in land lottery: **Jesse Tatum**, Revolutionary War soldier.<sup>14</sup>
- Bef 1830 **Probably Elbert Co., GA.** **Amy (Byrd) Tatum** died.
- 1830 **Elbert Co., GA.** Federal Census, Series M19, Roll 17, p. 155. **Jesse Tatum**. 1 male 70-79, 3 females 30-39, 1 female 15-19.
