

Julia Tatum and Lewis Brown Timeline

- abt 1760 **Unknown location. Lewis Brown** was born.
- abt 1778 **Unknown location. Julia Tatum** was born.
- abt 1804 **Pendleton District, SC. Julia Tatum & Lewis Brown** were married.
- 1810 **Pendleton District, SC.** Federal Census of **Louis Brown**, Roll 61, p. 209. 1 male and 1 female aged 26-44 (born 1766/1784); 1 female under 10 (born 1801/1810). No slaves.
- 25 Apr 1817 **Pendleton District, SC. Samuel Brown**, son, was born.
- 1820 **Pendleton District, SC.** Federal Census of **Lewis Browne**, p. 212, Roll M33_120. 1 male 26-44 (1776/1794), 2 males under 10 (1811/1820); 1 female 26-44 (1776/1794), 1 female 10-15 (1805/1810), 1 female under 10 (1811/1820). 1 slave. Household contains 1 foreigner, not naturalized.
- 1830 **Pickens District, SC.** Federal Census of **Lewis Brown**, Series M19, Roll 173, p. 316. 1 male 50-59 (1771/1780), 1 male 15-19 (1811/1815), 1 male 10-14 (1816/1820); 1 female 50-59 (1771/1780), 1 female 15-19 (1811/1815). 4 slaves.
- 1840 **Pickens District, SC.** Federal Census of **Lewis Brown**, Roll 514, p. 369. 1 male and 1 female 60-69 (1771/1780); 1 male 5-9 (1831-1835). The young male may be a grandchild. 6 slaves.
- 1843 **Pickens District, SC.** Box 1, #16, **Lewis Brown Griffin. Lewis Brown**, guardian for Lewis Brown Griffin, minor under 14. Lewis Brown, grandfather, has raised minor from infant. He was the son of Benjamin Griffin, whose wife Frances Brown is dead. From:

- 1850 **Pickens Co., SC (Eastern Division).** Federal Census of **Julia Brown**, aged 72 (b. 1778), NC, **Lewis Griffin**, 15 SC (1835) (grandchild). **Rilla or Della Howard**, 11 SC (1839) (grandchild). Roll M432857, p. 481, Family 441.
- 1860 Julia Brown not found.
- 1880 **Pickens Court House, Pickens Co., SC.** Federal Census of **Samuel Brown**, 65 (1815) SC, Mary A. Brown, 60 (1820) SC, Sarah A. Brown, 16 SC, Robt. B. Brown, 14 SC. Roll 1238, p. 12C, Enumeration District 128.

- 1847 **Pickens Co., SC. Lewis Brown** died. Wills, Vol. 1, Section 1, p. 155 (1828-1862).

1850 **Pickens District, Eastern District, SC.** Federal Census, Enumeration begun on 19th of July 1850, F. N. Garvin Assistant Marshall, House #441, family #441 list Julia Brown, age 72 [b. c1778], F, Estate 2000, born NC, with Lewis Griffin, age 15, M, Farming (this is son of daughter Frances), One, F age 11, Debby (Della, Deborah or Debby) Louisa Howard (this is daughter of daughter Linda).

1860 Julia died.

Frances married Benjamin Franklin Griffin, son of Sargent Griffin and Avarilla Barton. He was born ABT 1810 in SC, and died in Calhoun Co. AL.

Sadie married James Sutherland, son of William Sutherland. He was born ABT 1805 in Pendleton District, SC.

Tamie married unknown Howard. They may have died before 1850.

Samuel married Mary Ann Breazeale 10 Feb 1837. She was born 1821 in SC, and died in Pickens Co. SC. She was the daughter of George Washington Breazeale and Sara Bradshaw. She was born 24 Jul 1821, and died 6 Jun 1905 in buried Brown Family Cemetery, Griffin Ch Comm, Pickens Co., SC.
