

## Luke Tatum and Celia Murphree Timeline

- abt 1775     **Halifax Co., NC.** Son **Luke Tatum** was born to Edward Tatum & Martha (probably Bynum).
- 1790         **Hillsborough District, Chatham Co., NC.** **Edmond Tatom**, Federal Census, printed, p. 86. (see last page: 2 w males 16/older, 1 w m under 16, 2 w f, 4 slaves, series M637, roll 7, p. 218.) Son, Luke, is the male under 16 (born about 1775/1790).
- abt 1796     **Chatham Co., NC, or Pendleton District, SC.** Luke Tatum & Celia Murphree were married.
- abt 1797     **Pendleton District, SC.** **Annis C.**, daughter, was born to Luke Tatum & Celia Murphree.<sup>1</sup>
- abt 1800     **Pendleton District, SC.** Daughter, name unknown, was born to Luke Tatum & Celia Murphree.<sup>2</sup>
- abt 1801     **Pendleton District, SC.** Son, David, was born to Luke Tatum & Celia Murphree.<sup>3</sup>
- abt 1801     **Pendleton District, SC.** Daughter, Matilda, was born to Luke Tatum & Celia Murphree.<sup>4</sup>
- 05 Jun 1804 **Pendleton District, SC.** I **Edward Tatum** of Pendleton District do make this my last will and testament. I will my just debts be paid. I will to my son **Luke Tatum** three fourths of the land whereon I now live. I will to my daughter **Martha Tatum** the other fourth of the said land marked out by a line including my dwelling house, also two negro women **Jude** and **Annasa**, also all my stock of all kinds, with household and kitchen furniture. I will to my loving wife **Martha Tatum**. I will to my daughter **Elizabeth Hendrick** one negro name **Hannah**. I leave out the names of my other children, having already given them their portion. I do appoint my well beloved friend **William Curl** and **Solomon Murphree** my executors. Witnesses: **Hamilton Reid, Charles Durham, Joseph Stephens**.<sup>5</sup>
- abt 1806     **Pendleton District, SC.** Daughter, Martha, was born to Luke Tatum & Celia Murphree.<sup>6</sup>
- abt 1805/1810 **Pendleton District, SC.** Daughter, name unknown, was born to Luke Tatum & Celia Murphree.<sup>7</sup>

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<sup>1</sup> Note: I cannot prove that Annis was a daughter of this couple; however, a direct descendant of Annis (Tatum) Luker named Shirley Walker Horton has an autosomal DNA match with me at Family Tree DNA at a 5<sup>th</sup> cousin to remote cousin level. A female of the right age is in the 1800, 1810, and 1820 censuses for Luke Tatum.

<sup>2</sup> Female born about 1800 is inferred from the 1800, 1810, and 1820 censuses for Luke Tatum and his household.

<sup>3</sup> Note: I cannot prove that David was a son of this couple, but he was in the 1830 Federal Census near Celia Tatum, widow. A male of approximately the right age is in the 1820 census.

<sup>4</sup> Note: I cannot prove that Matilda was a daughter; she is alleged to be, according to Internet family trees, undocumented. A female of the right age is in the 1810 and 1820 censuses for Luke Tatum.

- 28 Dec 1810 **Pendleton District, SC.** The will of **Edward Tatum** was proved. He is buried at Bethlehem Methodist Church Cemetery, Pickens County, South Carolina, with no headstone.<sup>8</sup>
- 1810 **Pendleton District, SC.** Federal Census. **Luke Tatum**, next door to his mother, p. 142A. Duplicate census for him next door to his mother is on p. 147A. In the former entry an older couple, male and female aged 45 or older, may be Celia Murphree's parents or uncle and aunt of Luke or Celia. Composition of census entry is on last page. 1 slave is shown on p. 142A, no slaves shown on p. 147A.
- 1810 **Pendleton District, SC.** Federal Census. **Patsey Tatum.** 1 f 45/older (1765 or earlier), no other members of household, no slaves (Patsey is a nickname for Martha.) Roll 61, p. 142A.
- abt 1811/1820 **Pendleton District, SC, or Dallas Co., AL.** Daughter, name unknown, was born to Luke Tatum & Celia Murphree.<sup>9</sup>
- abt 1814 **Alabama.** Son, Aaron M., was born to Luke Tatum & Celia Murphree.<sup>10</sup>
- abt 1815 **Alabama.** Son, Daniel., was born to Luke Tatum & Celia Murphree.<sup>11</sup>
- abt 1816/1820 **Alabama.** Daughter, name unknown, was born to Luke Tatum & Celia Murphree.<sup>12</sup>
- 1820 **Dallas Co., AL.** State census, **Luke Tatum.** 1 m over 21, 3 m under 21, 2 f over 21, 5 f under 21, no slaves.
- 1821/1825 **Dallas Co., AL.** Son, name unknown (Joseph?), was born to Luke Tatum & Celia Murphree.<sup>13</sup>
- 19 Apr 1824 **Dallas Co., AL.** **Martha Tatum & Samuel Shelton** were married.
- 14 Apr 1825 **Dallas Co., AL.** **Annis Tatum & Joshua Luker** were married.
- bef 1830 **Probably Dallas Co., AL.** Luke Tatum died.
- 1830 **Dallas Co., AL.** Federal Census, **Celia Tatum**, Series M19, Roll 2, p. 86. Celia was not found after 1830. Either she died or remarried an unknown man.
- 06 Jul 1837 **Blount Co., AL..** **Daniel Tatum & Malissa Lloyd** were married.

<sup>13</sup> Male born about 1821/1825 (aged 5-9) is inferred from 1830 census for Celia Tatum.
