_Hugh Tatum bought 202 1/2 acres of land on 12 Mile Creek(in Pendleton District, SC)in 1814 and sold it in 1833 to George Hindrix. Solomon Tatum bought property on the same creek in 1829 and sold it in 1832,the deed being signed by his wife, Susanna, who was a Trotter before marriage. John Tatum owned property on same creek.

John and Anice Christina Rowland Tatum

John Tatum was born in Pickens County, SC 10-15-1814, died 5-24-1897. He was married to Anice Christina Rowland, born 2-6-1821, died 11-17-1879.

John (Jack) Tatum was the son of Hugh Tatum, 1782-1862, and Mary Roe, daughter of Solomon Roe. John Tatum was named for his grandfather, John Tatum who lived in Anderson, SC at the time of his death in 1824.

John (Jack) came to Dawson County (then Lumpkin) in the 1830's when he was about 20 years of age. He settled in the Southeastern part of the county. John was the only son of Hugh and Mary who remained close to his parents and is buried near them in Liberty Church Cemetery.

It is thought that John dealt in Real Estate because he had vast acreage of land at one time.

John served with the Confederate States of American in 1861 but became discouraged and later pledged his allegiance to the US.. Many people in Dawson County did not believe in the Confederate cause, and most of his family were Republicans who supported Lincoln.

John and Anice lived, at the time of their death, at the corner where Blue Ridge Overlook now intersects with Jot-Em-Down Road in Forsyth County.

There were five children born to John and Anice: Hugh McAfee born 1854, died 1932, married Exer Duncan, daughter of Jim and Nan Duncan; William Benson, born 1856, died 1913, married Alice C. Taylor, daughter of Ausborn and Nancy Jane Kennedy Taylor; Emma, born 1861, married Tom Rives, son of Jackie Rives; Jane married (1) Elisa Townsend and (2) Martin Barker; Lynn married John E. Robertson.

When each of John Tatum's children were married, he gave them a farm, the land lying along Thompson Creek, now a Park of Lake Lanier. The subdivisions there now once belonged to John's descendants. They are Hatteras-on-Lanier and Oak Harbor to William Benson's family. Hidden Horizons belonged to Hugh McAfee, Sunrise to Emma Barker's family, Waters Edge to Lynn Robertson's descendants and Overlook to Emma Rives' family.
