

Jesse Tatum, possible son of John Tatum & unknown of Pendleton District, South Carolina

NOTE: John Tatum had two sons born 1795/1800, according to the 1800 and 1810 censuses for him in Pendleton District, SC. It is likely that one was this Jesse Tatum because of his location in the vicinity of Yalobusha Co., MS, when John's daughter, Sarah, & her husband, Carter Cannon, were there.

- 23 Jan 1798 **Pendleton District, SC. Jesse Tatum** was born.¹
- 24 Mar 1818 **Anderson Co., SC. Jesse Tatum** sold to **William Cox** 688 acres. Book O, p. 361. Which Jesse Tatum was this? Was this the son of Edward & Martha or of John & unknown?
- Abt 1820 **Perhaps Pendleton District, SC. Jesse Tatum & Mary Carleton** were married. She was born 20 Dec 1793 in Pendleton Co., SC.
- 1824-1839 **Tuscaloosa Co., AL. Jesse Tatum** had land here.
- 1830 **Tuscaloosa Co., AL.** Federal Census, Series M19, Roll 3, p. 301: **Jesse Tatum**. From www.ancestry.com.
- Abt 1830 **South Carolina or Alabama. Jesse Tatum** married (2) **Nancy** (b. c.1810 SC).
- 1840 Not found, may have been in Calhoun Co., MS, or Yalobusha Co., MS.
- 09 Apr 1842 **Calhoun Co., MS. Jesse Tatum** had 2 separate land patents, one showing that he resided in Lafayette Co., MS, and one showing that he lived in Yalobusha Co., MS. (A Jesse Tatum listed on the 1841 Tippah Co., MS, census was too young to be this Jesse Tatum.)
- 1850 **Yalobusha Co., MS.** Federal Census, north of the Yallobusha River, Roll M432_382, p. 429B: **Jessee Tatom, wife Nancy**, 4 children. From www.ancestry.com.
- 01 Jul 1859 **Independence Co., AR. Jesse Tatum** obtained 80 acres on the 5th PM Meridian, Twp 11-N, Range 7-W, Section 4, Accession # AR0690_.352, Batesville Land Office.
- 1860 **Liberty, Independence Co., AR.** Federal Census, Roll M653_43, p. 252, Pleasant Plains P.O., Family #1710: **Jesse Tatum**, aged 62 (b. 1798), SC, was in the household of his son, **Joseph**, and his wife **Nancy A.** From: www.ancestry.com.
- 01 May 1860 **Cleburn Co., AR.** (Bordering Independence Co.) **Jesse Tatum**, 120 acres in Section 35, Twp 12N, Range 8W.
- 28 Oct 1862 **Independence Co., AR. Jesse Tatum**, age 64 [abt 1798], married (3) **Rebecca Collins**, age 39 [born abt 1823], were married.²

- 1861/1865 During the Civil War Jesse Tatum was for the Union, according to a posting on the Internet by Bernie Moore-Knowles, knowmoore11@cox.net, citing writings by his daughter, Nancy Ann Kizzaruh Tatum, stating that Jesse “held to the Union of the United States while most everyone gave in during the hard conflict between the North and the South.
- 1867 **Independence Co., AR. Jesse Tatum** made his will, which mentioned only one child, **Nancy A. K. Tatum**. Will Book B, p. 202.
- 1870 **Liberty, Independence Co., AR.** Federal Census, M593_55, p. 123B. **Jesse Tatum**, 72, born about 1798, white male, Batesville P.O. From www.ancestry.com.
- 1873 **Independence Co., AR.** Daughter, **Nancy**, recalled that **Jesse Tatum** died then, when she was 8 years old.
- 1876 **Independence Co., AR.** Family Bible indicates he died about this date.
