Nathaniel Tatum, Jr., died by the following date:  
 29 Sep 1815 Hancock Co.. GA. Peter Tatum deeded to Thomas Townsend, both of Hancock County, for \$700, 287 1/2 acres in Hancock County wherein Peter Tatum now lives, bounded by lands of John Alford, Minse Sledge, Elijah Palmore, John Thomas. Being the land that was sold and conveyed a certain Thomas Harriss of Warren County, Georgia (who was) Administrator of Abr\_\_ MGregor to Nathl Tatum, deceased Father of the said Peter Tatum, by a deed bearing the date of 28 February 1802, recorded in the county of Hancock. ...land according to law was sold by Peter Tatum and William Tatum, Administrators of the deceased father, the said Nathl Tatum. And which the said Peter Tatum at a Publick Sale became the purchaser. Land is (defined) by Harriss and Nathl Tatum lines. Signed - Peter Tatum (seal). Witnesses - Elisha Cain, F. Lewis, J.P. Registered 5 July 1816. Hancock County, Georgia, Deed

CHILD 2 - Sarah Tatum

Per THE MARYLAND DENTS, she was living in Hancock Co. in 1827, when she was entitled to the land lottery of that year and drew a "specified acreage" of former Indian land in Muscogee Co." (p. 74)

Steven Mays of Dallas, Texas, now deceased, provided date of marriage, which he received from Marvin Tatum, who got it from Mrs. Rae Tatum Malone. It needs to be verified.

CHILD 3 - Mary "Polly" Tatum

1840 Federal Census of Talbot Co., Georgia, Roll 51, p. 212: George Manifee (Menefee): 1 male and 1 female aged 70-79 (born 1761-1770) and 28 slaves.

CHILD 4 - Peter Tatum

This is the Peter Tatum who was a brother of Nathaniel Tatum, who died in 1808 in Hancock Co., Georgia, according to "Nathaniel Tatum of Hancock County, GA," owned by "pamelasdowns" of Georgia at www.ancestry.com; accessed 18 April 2015.

CHILD 5 - Seth Tatum

Steven Mays of Dallas, Texas, now deceased, wrote: "Seth Tatum was alive in Greene Co., GA, as he applied to be administrator of Burrell PEEBLES' estate before his sister [Rebecca] married in 1802 to Daniel EASLEY. He was dead before will of brother Nathaniel was written. Seth had a legatee Rees TATUM."

Death: ABT APR 1808 in Hancock Co., Georgia. Probate: Letters of Administration granted May 2, 1808.

CHILD 7 - William Tatum

Tatum family papers at Sanford University, Birmingham, AL, say Seth was the father of Albert, Phala, and Judson Tatum. Steven Mays thinks family naming patterns suggest that William Tatum, brother of Seth and Nathaniel Jr., was the father. No marriage records have been found yet. NEW INFORMATION/SEE BELOW, WHICH INDICATES WILLIAM WAS AGNES'S SECOND HUSBAND AND FATHER OF ALBERT, JUDSON, AND PHALA.

The 1820 and 1830 censuses of Hancock Co., GA, for the household of William Tatum/Tatom show a husband and a wife born 1770-1780 and three children who fit as Albert, Judson, and Phala.

According to Agnes's descendant, the late Steven Griffin Mays, of Duncanville TX, Agnes is buried in Gold Hill (10 miles south of Auburn, in Chambers Co., AL. Hers is the oldest known marked grave in Gold Hill, according to Mary Lauderdale, Route 1, Box 42A, Waverly AL 36879, "Menefee/Tatum Family Information," TAPROOT, pub. by East Alabama Genealogical Society, Auburn, AL, September 1987 (or slightly later date?). His information is that the burial records give her birth date as 1776. Husband, William Tatum, born in 1776 also.

A deed between Albert Tatum, son and buyer, and William Tatum, father/seller, in Macon Co., AL (Tuskegee is county seat), dated 8 Aug 1843, Deed Book E, p. 356. Land borders Hamling Tatum's property. A descendant of Hamling Tatum is Marvin P. Tatum, 1823 Gloucester Place, Clinton, MS 39056. Marvin provided Steven Mays with some of the above information.

CHILD 8 - Nathaniel Tatum III

Although the will of Nathaniel Tatum, Jr., dated 19 Sep 1808 (inventory 26 Oct 1808), Hancock Co., GA, stated that his wife was Agnes B., he clearly died before Albert Tatum's date of birth. Agnes appeared to have married 2nd, Seth Tatum, according to Tatum family papers at Sanford University, Birmingham, AL. However, Steven Mays, descendant of Agnes's son Albert, believed her second husband was William Tatum, another brother.

Will of Nathaniel Tatum, Hancock County, Georgia Book F, Page 1, Signed 19 Sept 1808

(The upper left corner of this will is torn away, so there are gaps in the text.)

-----the name of ---- Amen-----thaniel Tatum of the State of Georgia---County of Hancock---being of a sound---mind do make and ordain th-----will and testament revoking all ---- I should have heretofore made---- and bequeath unto my dear sister ---- Easley the sum of one dollar and --- cents, and I also give unto my nephew Reese Tatum the sum of one dollar and fifty cents, also my sister Sarah Dent the sum of one dollar and fifty cents and unto my affectionate father Nathaniel Tatum and unto the surviving heirs of my sister Polly Manifee also William Tatum, James Tatum and Peter Tatum and each of them the sum of one dollar and seventy five cents and I also give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Agnes B. Tatum the tract of land containing one hundred and ninety four acres whereon I do now live and six negroes named as follows. Love, Jerry, Ginny, Ozra, Hampton and Mariah also all the household furniture, three head of horses(?), stock of cattle and hogs and all plantation tolls, also all debts due to me, after the discharge of all my legal debts. Ilikewise to make, appoint and constitute my beloved wife Agnes P. Tatum and William Tatum the sole executrix and executor of this my last will and testament. In writing hereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 19th Sept 1808Test by Nathl Tatum (seal) Henry Miller William Miller Elizabeth (her X mark) Miller
